## **Inspection & Testing Overview**


All inspection and testing procedures were conducted within the **European Union** under controlled conditions.

Procedures Performed:

- Complete disassembly and reassembly.
- Structural integrity and component condition checks.
- Headspace and timing verification.
- Ballistic function testing (live fire) conducted on representative sample units.

A total of 130 documented test protocols are available, including:

- Confirmation that the majority of used units exhibit an average service life of approximately 5,000 rounds fired.
- Detailed wear and condition analysis, recorded and traceable by individual serial number(s).



## **Included Components**

Each AN/M3 unit is supplied with the following core receiver group and operating assemblies:

- Receiver group with breech lock cam assembly.
- Original .50 caliber aircraft barrel.
- Back plate assembly.
- Oil buffer assembly.
- Bolt group and bolt stud.
- Extractor switch.
- Barrel extension with shank, locking spring, and breech.
- Adjustable trigger bar with locking pin.
- Cartridge stops (front and rear).
- Belt holding pawls with locking pin.
- Cover group assembly, including belt feed lever, slide, and pawl arm.



## **Not Included Components**

The following items are not included with the AN/M3 units offered:

- Trigger.
- Handle (spade grip).
- Bolt release latch.
- Cocking handle group.
- Barrel support / jacket.
- Trunnion block.
- Single-shot mechanism.
